



DAR AL NAIM

Dar Al Naim est une artiste soudanaise-espagnole, actuellement installée à Fuerteventura, dans les îles Canaries. Sa pratique créative puise dans son parcours de vie nomade – entre le Soudan, l'Espagne, l'Italie, le Royaume-Uni et la Tanzanie – et témoigne d'une identité façonnée par la diaspora. À travers une variété de médiums (impression, gravure, dessin à l'encre, peinture mixte et collage), elle s'attache à révéler la complexité de l'existence humaine, notamment les épreuves vécues par ceux qui subissent la guerre, l'injustice et l'exil.

Dar Al Naim is a Sudanese-Spanish artist currently based in Fuerteventura in the Canary Islands. Her creative practice draws on her nomadic life—split between Sudan, Spain, Italy, the UK, and Tanzania—and reflects an identity shaped by the diaspora. Working across various mediums, including printmaking, drawing, painting, and collage, she explores the human condition, often focusing on the struggles faced by those enduring war, injustice, and exile.
